BY-LAW

A by-law amending the provisions of the Letters Patent and authorizing an application for the issue of Supplementary Letters Patent to confirm the same.

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a by-law of Canadian Internet Registration Authority / Autorité canadienne pour les enregistrements Internet (the "Corporation"):

1. That, subject to confirmation by Supplementary Letters Patent, Part III of the Letters Patent of the Corporation is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

The objects of the Corporation are:

- (a) to act as the registry for the .CA Internet domain;
- (b) to provide professional registry services comparable to other major national and international Internet registries;
- (c) to develop, carry out and/or support any other Internet-related activities in Canada; and
- (d) to do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
- 2. That the Corporation be and is hereby authorized to make an application to the Minister of Industry for the issue of Supplementary Letters Patent confirming this by-law insofar as it relates to amending the provisions of the Letters Patent.
- 3. That the directors and officers are hereby authorized and directed to do, sign and execute all things, deeds and documents necessary or desirable for the due carrying out of the foregoing.
